United Mine Workers of America hereby petitions this Court, pursuant to Rule 15 of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure and Section 307(b)(1) of the Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7607(b)(1), to review the final agency action by respondent United States Environmental Protection Agency entitled “Carbon Pollution Emission Guidelines for Existing Stationary Sources: Electric Utility Generating Units” published in the Federal Register at 80 Fed. Reg. 64,662 on October 23, 2015.
