PETITION FOR REVIEW

ORIGINAL Pursuant to Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 15, 5 U.S.C. § 702, and Section 307(b)(1) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. § 7607(b)(1)), Peabody Energy Corp. petitions this Court for review of the final rule "Standards of Performance for Greenhouse Gas Emissions From New, Modified, and Reconstructed Stationary Sources: Electric Utility Generating Units," promulgated by the Environmental Protection Agency on August 3, 2015, and published in the Federal Register at 80 Fed. Reg. 64,510 on October 23, 2015. This Court has jurisdiction and is a proper venue for this action under Section 307(b)(1) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. § 7607(b)(1)).

Petitioner will show that the final rule is in excess of the agency's statutory authority, violates the United States Constitution, and otherwise is arbitrary, capricious, an abuse of discretion and not in accordance with law. Accordingly, Petitioners ask the Court to hold unlawful and set aside the rule, and to order other such relief as may be appropriate. *See* 42 U.S.C. § 7607(d).

Other petitions relating to the same Rule have been consolidated with No. 15-1381.
