Pursuant to section 307(b)(1) of the Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7607(b)(1), and Rule 15(a) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure, the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association and the above-named member rural electric cooperatives hereby petition the Court for review of the final action of Respondent United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA"): "Standards of Performance for Greenhouse Gas Emissions From New, Modified, and Reconstructed Stationary Sources: Electric Utility Generating Units," to be codified at 40 C.F.R. Part 60, Subpart TTTT (the "Final Rule"). The Final Rule

was published in the Federal Register at 80 Fed. Reg. 64,510 on October 23,

2015. A copy of EPA's Final Rule is attached to this Petition.

This Petition is timely filed within sixty days of that publication as required by Clean Air Act section 307(b)(1).
